SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 1 proposing a constitutional amendment establishing a right for 2 certain residents receiving care in residential settings to 3 4 designate an essential caregiver for in-person visitation. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Article I, Texas Constitution, is amended by 7 adding Section 35 to read as follows: 8 Sec. 35. (a) A resident of a nursing facility, assisted living facility, intermediate care facility for individuals with an 9 10 intellectual disability, residence providing home and 11 community-based services, or state supported living center, as those terms are defined by general law, has the right to designate 12 an essential caregiver with whom the facility, residence, or center 13 may not prohibit in-person visitation. 14 15 (b) The legislature by general law may provide for guidelines for a facility, residence, or center described by 16 Subsection (a) of this section to follow in establishing essential 17 caregiver visitation policies and procedures. 18 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 19 20 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021. The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the 21

22 proposition: "The constitutional amendment establishing a right 23 for certain residents receiving care in residential settings to 24 designate an essential caregiver for in-person visitation."
