SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1-20 proposing a constitutional amendment establishing a right for 1-21 certain residents receiving care in residential settings to 1-22 designate an essential caregiver for in-person visitation. 1-23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Article I, Texas Constitution, is amended by adding Section 35 to read as follows:

(a) A resident of a nursing facility, assisted 1-27 living facility, intermediate care facility for individuals with an 1-28 intellectual disability, residence providing home and 1-29 community-based services, or state supported living center, as 1-30 those terms are defined by general law, has the right to designate 1-31 an essential caregiver with whom the facility, residence, or center 1-32 may not prohibit in-person visitation.
