## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to prohibit the legislature
- 2 from requiring a license or permit for the wearing of arms.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 23, Article I, Texas Constitution, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 23. (a) Every citizen shall have the right to keep and
- 7 bear arms in the lawful defense of himself or the State.
- 8 (b) The [; but the] Legislature shall have power, by law, to
- 9 regulate the wearing of arms, with a view to prevent crime, but may
- 10 not require a citizen of this state to obtain a license or permit to
- 11 wear arms.
- 12 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021.
- 14 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 15 proposition: "The constitutional amendment prohibiting the
- 16 legislature from requiring a license or permit for the wearing of
- 17 arms."
