A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the lieutenant
- 2 governor and speaker of the house of representatives to call the
- 3 legislature into special session and to designate the subjects of

- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 5A to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 5A. The lieutenant governor and speaker of the house of
- 9 representatives may by joint proclamation convene the legislature
- 10 in special session.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 40, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 40. (a) When the <u>legislature is</u> [Legislature shall be]
- 14 convened in a special session authorized by Section 5A of this
- 15 <u>article or Section 8(a), Article IV, of this constitution, the</u>
- 16 <u>legislature may not consider</u> [there shall be no] legislation on a
- 17 <u>subject</u> [upon subjects] other than <u>a subject</u> [those] designated in
- 18 the proclamation [of the Governor] calling the [such] session, [or]
- 19 presented to the legislature [them] by the governor, or presented
- 20 to the legislature jointly by the lieutenant governor and the
- 21 speaker of the house of representatives.
- 22 <u>(b) No special</u> [Governor; and no such] session shall be of
- 23 longer duration than thirty days.
- 24 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be

- 1 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021.
- 2 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 3 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 4 lieutenant governor and speaker of the house of representatives to
- 5 call the legislature into special session and to designate the
- 6 subjects of legislation considered at certain special sessions."
