1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

- 7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 1-b(m), Article VIII, Texas
- 9 Constitution, is amended to read as follows:
- 10 (m) The legislature by general law may provide that the
- 11 surviving spouse of a member of the armed services of the United
- 12 States who is killed or fatally injured in the line of duty [in
- 13 action] is entitled to an exemption from ad valorem taxation of all
- 14 or part of the market value of the surviving spouse's residence
- 15 homestead if the surviving spouse has not remarried since the death
- 16 of the member of the armed services.
- 17 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 18 the Texas Constitution:
- 19 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 20 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 87th Legislature,
- 21 Regular Session, 2021, authorizing the legislature to provide for
- 22 an exemption from ad valorem taxation of all or part of the market
- 23 value of the residence homestead of the surviving spouse of a member
- 24 of the armed services of the United States who is killed or fatally

- 1 <u>injured in the line of duty.</u>
- 2 (b) The amendment to Section 1-b(m), Article VIII, of this
- 3 constitution takes effect January 1, 2022, and applies only to a tax
- 4 year beginning on or after that date.
- 5 <u>(c)</u> This temporary provision expires January 1, 2023.
- 6 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 7 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021.
- 8 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 9 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 10 legislature to provide for an exemption from ad valorem taxation of
- 11 all or part of the market value of the residence homestead of the
- 12 surviving spouse of a member of the armed services of the United
- 13 States who is killed or fatally injured in the line of duty."
