WHEREAS, Mr. Holmes was the proud father of five children, Analiese, Christina, Joed, James, and Timothy, and he was eventually blessed with nine grandchildren; he read to all of them when they were young, ensuring that they developed good language skills, and he always inscribed their birthday cards

with wise and encouraging messages; the devoted husband of Teresa Fabiola, he was preceded in death by his first wife, Cynthia Holmes; he was a man of deep faith, and as a young man, he worked with The Navigators discipleship ministry; through the years, he loved to memorize scripture, and he inspired his family to read the Bible and follow its tenets; moreover, he was an enthusiastic fan of Aggie football and attended every home game; and
