**IN RE:** HB46 by Fierro (relating to the opportunity to correct a vote by mail application.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

It is assumed that the costs associated with the bill's provisions relating to the opportunity to correct a vote by mail application could be absorbed using existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

According to the election administrators for Cameron, El Paso, Washington and Williamson Counties, the bill would have no fiscal impact on their counties. No significant fiscal implication to other units of local government is anticipated.
