<p><b>No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.</b></p>
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It is assumed that the costs associated with the bill's provisions relating to supplemental information required for inclusion with a written statement of an individualized education program developed for certain public school students who received special education services during the 2019-2020 or 2020-2021 school year could be absorbed using existing resources.

The bill's provisions would require school districts and charter schools to create new forms and collect additional data on impacted students.
