IN RE: HB293 by Collier (Relating to health benefit coverage for certain fertility preservation services under certain health benefit plans.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Insurance Code relating to health benefit coverage for fertility preservation services. It is assumed that the duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
