IN RE: HB434 by Bell, Keith (Relating to the curriculum requirements for public high school students.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that the provisions of the bill relating to the curriculum requirements for public high school students could be absorbed using existing resources.

Local Government Impact

The impact to school districts and charter schools cannot be determined. If schools expand Fine Arts and Career and Technical Education course offerings to meet the bill's requirements, additional costs may be incurred at the local level.
