IN RE: HB461 by Shaheen (Relating to the execution of a warrant issued for certain releasees who violate a condition of release on parole or to mandatory supervision.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that the provisions of the bill relating to the execution of a warrant issued for certain individuals who violate a condition of release on parole or mandatory supervision could be absorbed using existing resources.
