**IN RE: HB639** by White (Relating to the authority of an emergency services district to provide public health services; authorizing a fee.), **As Introduced** 

#### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to authorize an emergency services district to provide public health services; contract with the state or local government to provide the services; and charge a reasonable fee for performing the services. It is assumed that any activities relating to the provisions of the bill can be implemented within existing resources.

## **Local Government Impact**

The City of Houston anticipates no fiscal implication to the city. To the extent emergency services districts could collect fees pursuant to this bill, there could be a positive effect on the revenue of units of local government.
