IN RE: HB661 by Beckley (relating to voting system equipment used by counties participating in the countywide polling place program.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would amend the Texas Election Code to expand the categories of voting system equipment that a county must use to qualify for the countywide polling place program.

According to the Secretary of State, no significant fiscal impact is anticipated.
