It is assumed that the costs associated with the bill's provisions relating to required cardiopulmonary resuscitation training for certain telecommunicators could be absorbed using existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

Bexar County anticipates a cost of \$10,720 for the initial training of personnel, and \$160 per individual employee hired thereafter.

Fannin County anticipates a cost of \$2,400 per year for additional training requirements.
