IN RE: HB871 by Morrison (Relating to the municipal fees charged to certain air conditioning and refrigeration contractors.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Occupations Code to prohibit a municipality from charging a registration fee to certain air conditioning and refrigeration contractors.

Local Government Impact

The City of Plano anticipates a cost of \$20,000 annually in lost registration fee revenue.

The City of Houston anticipates a cost of \$650,000 in fiscal year 2022 in lost registration fee revenue. The city anticipates that cost to increase by an additional \$10,000 each subsequent fiscal year through fiscal year 2026 due to projected growth in these registrations.
