IN RE: HB911 by Patterson (Relating to the issuance of specially marked driver's licenses and personal identification certificates to veterans.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that the costs associated with the bill's provisions relating to the issuance of specially marked driver's licenses and personal identification certificates to veterans could be absorbed using existing resources.

This analysis assumes the provisions of the bill would not result in a significant impact on state correctional populations or on the demand for state correctional resources.
