IN RE: HB1379 by Patterson (Relating to required notice prohibiting firearms at certain businesses selling or serving alcoholic beverages and the prohibition on carrying certain weapons on those premises.), As Introduced

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission indicates that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.

This analysis assumes implementing the provisions of the bill addressing felony sanctions for criminal offenses would not result in a significant impact on state correctional agencies.
