**IN RE: HB1574 by Landgraf (Relating to signs posted under the memorial sign program for victims of certain vehicle accidents.), As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to extend from two years to ten years the period of time a sign may be posted under the Texas Department of Transportation's (TxDOT) memorial sign program for victims of alcohol or controlled substance-related vehicle accidents.

Based on the information provided by TxDOT, it is assumed implementation of the bill would not result in a significant operational or fiscal impact to TxDOT or the State.
