**IN RE: HB1661** by Pacheco (Relating to state recognition of the Tap Pilam Coahuiltecan Nation.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Government Code to codify the state's designation and recognition of the Tap Pilam Coahuiltecan Nation as a Native American Indian Tribe.

According to the Texas Historical Commission and the Secretary of State, no significant fiscal impact to the state is anticipated.
