IN RE: HB1674 by Holland (Relating to the taking of a blood specimen on arrest following certain motor vehicle accidents.), As Introduced

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code as it relates to the taking of a blood specimen on arrest following certain motor vehicle accidents.

This analysis assumes the provisions of the bill would not result in a significant impact on state correctional populations or on the demand for state correctional resources.
