IN RE: HB1932 by Thompson, Senfronia (Relating to notice of available alternatives to the lapse or surrender of a life insurance policy.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Insurance Code relating to notice of available alternatives to the lapse or surrender of a life insurance policy. Based on information provided by the Texas Department of Insurance, Employees Retirement System, Texas A&M University System Administration, and UT System Administration, this analysis assumes that the duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
