IN RE: **HB1957** by Kuempel (relating to the labeling of wine as originating from an area of this state or with the name of a vineyard in this state.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Alcoholic Beverage Code as it relates the labeling of wine as originating from an area of this state. The Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission and the Texas Department of Agriculture anticipate that the provisions of the bill would not result in a significant fiscal impact.
