IN RE: HB2001 by Canales (Relating to procedures and practices governing the appeal of a disciplinary action within the Department of Public Safety.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that the costs associated with the bill's provisions relating to procedures and practices governing the appeal of a disciplinary action within the Department of Public Safety could be absorbed using existing resources.

This analysis assumes implementing the provisions of the bill would not result in a significant impact on state correctional populations or on the demand for state correctional resources.
