IN RE: HB2036 by Johnson, Julie (Relating to the definition of close relative of a deceased victim for purposes of certain laws relating to the release of an inmate on parole or to mandatory supervision.),
As Engrossed

<p>No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.</p>

The bill would amend the Government Code as it relates to the definition of a close relative of a deceased victim under certain circumstances. It is assumed that the costs associated with the bill's provisions could be absorbed using existing resources.

This analysis assumes implementing the provisions of the bill would not result in a significant impact on state correctional populations or on the demand for state correctional resources.

Local Government Impact
