**IN RE: HB2213** by Frullo (Relating to the slaughter and processing of exotic animals for donation to a nonprofit food bank.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would provide an exemption for inspection related to the donation of hunter-killed exotic game animals to nonprofit food banks. The Department of State Health Services indicates it could implement the provisions of the bill within current resources.
