IN RE: HB2213 by Frullo (relating to the slaughter and processing of exotic animals for donation to a nonprofit food bank.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would provide an exemption for inspection related to the donation of hunter-killed exotic game animals to nonprofit food banks. The Department of State Health Services indicates it could implement the provisions of the bill within current resources.
