IN RE: HB2295 by Wu (Relating to allowing certain counties to cease operation of a juvenile justice alternative education program.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Education and Family Codes to allow certain counties to cease operation of a juvenile justice alternative education program.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill's provisions could be absorbed using existing resources.
