IN RE: HB2309 by Dominguez (Relating to the penalties for the illegal use of a parking space or area designated specifically for persons with disabilities; increasing criminal fines.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Section 681.011 of the Transportation Code to increase fines for the illegal use of a parking space designated for persons with disabilities.

Based on the analysis of the Department of Motor Vehicles, it is assumed the provisions of the bill would not result in a significant fiscal impact to the State.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
