**IN RE: HB2365** by Lopez (Relating to the participation and reimbursement of certain military medical treatment facilities and affiliated health care providers under Medicaid.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Human Resources Code to require Medicaid reimbursement for a military medical treatment facility verified as level 1 trauma center for certain services. The bill would also prohibit the Health and Human Services Commission from imposing time limits on inpatient emergency services at a military medical treatment facility verified as level 1 trauma center.

The Health and Human Services Commission indicates that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
