**IN RE: HB2650** by Johnson, Jarvis (Relating to law enforcement agency policies regarding the placement of a child taken into possession by a peace officer during the arrest of a person.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure to require each law enforcement agency to adopt a written policy regarding the safe placement of a child who is in the care, custody, or control of a person at the time the person is arrested.

This analysis assumes the provisions of the bill would not result in a significant impact on state correctional populations or on the demand for state correctional resources and that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

According to the Texas Association of Counties, no significant fiscal impact to counties is anticipated.
