**IN RE: HB2761** by Israel (relating to disclosure requirements for accident and health coverage and health expense arrangements marketed to individuals.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Insurance Code relating to disclosure requirements for accident and health coverage and health expense arrangements marketed to individuals. Based on information provided by the Texas Department of Insurance and Health and Human Services Commission, this analysis assumes that the duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
