**IN RE: HB2954** by Thompson, Senfronia (Relating to a suicide prevention, intervention, and postvention program for certain public elementary schools.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

It is assumed that the costs associated with the bill's provisions relating to a suicide prevention, intervention, and postvention program for certain public elementary school campuses could be absorbed using existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

School districts and charter schools that establish a local suicide prevention, intervention, and postvention program may incur additional costs of participation, including the provision of significant resources to participating schools.
