IN RE: HB3012 by Geren (Relating to charitable raffles conducted by the charitable foundations of certain professional sports teams.), **As Introduced**

<p>No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.</p>

The bill adds the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association to the list of professional sports teams defined in Section 2004.002 of the Occupations Code and for which a professional sports team charitable foundation is permitted to conduct a charitable raffle.

According to the Office of the Attorney General and the Texas Lottery Commission, any work resulting from the provisions of the bill could reasonably be absorbed within current resources.

According to the Comptroller's Office of Public Accounts, no fiscal impact is anticipated.
