IN RE: HB3022 by Herrero (Relating to the expunction of arrest records and files by a statutory county court.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Articles 55.01 and 55.02, Code of Criminal Procedure, to allow a statutory court to issue certain orders of expunction in cases over which a statutory court court has jurisdiction.
