IN RE: HB3075 by Coleman (Relating to the collection and reporting of certain information regarding mental health jail diversion.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that the costs associated with the bill's provisions relating to the collection and reporting of certain information regarding mental health jail diversion could be absorbed using existing resources.

This analysis assumes the provisions of the bill would not result in a significant impact on state correctional populations or on the demand for state correctional resources.
