IN RE: HB3120 by Capriglione (Relating to the eligibility of an injured employee for lifetime income benefits under the workers' compensation system.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Labor Code relating to the eligibility of an injured employee for lifetime income benefits under the workers' compensation system. Based on information provided by the Texas Department of Insurance, this analysis assumes that the duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
