IN RE: HB3269 by Noble (Relating to the requirement that a ballot to be voted by mail be canceled and returned before voting in person.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Election Code as it relates to the requirement that a ballot to be voted by mail be canceled and returned before voting in person.

The Secretary of State indicates that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.
