IN RE: HB3303 by Schofield (Relating to the procedure for making any change from any voting standard, practice, or procedure authorized by the Election Code), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would amend the Election Code to provide that an election official of the state or of a political subdivision may not create, alter, or suspend any voting standard, practice, or procedure in a manner not expressly authorized by the Election Code.

According to the Secretary of State, no significant fiscal impact to the state is anticipated.
