IN RE: HB3373 by Burrows (Relating to the certification of live music venues by and other duties of the Texas Music Office.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill designates the Texas Music Office with the authority of issuing certifications for independent live music venues and administering federal programs that support independent live music venues, operators, producers, or promoters.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.
