**IN RE: HB3415** by Goldman (Relating to the authority of certain counties to require photo identification to file certain documents with the county clerk.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to expand the population threshold for counties that may opt to require a person filing certain records with the county clerk to provide a photo identification.
