**IN RE:** **HB3496** by Herrero (Relating to the designation of State Highway 358 as the Peace Officers Memorial Highway.), **As Engrossed**

<b>No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.</b>

The bill would amend Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code, to require the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to design, construct, and erect highway markers naming a specific portion or segment of state highway.

Based on the information provided by TxDOT, it is assumed any costs or duties associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
