IN RE: HB3622 by Hefner (relating to the eligibility of certain physicians to provide and receive remuneration for workers' compensation health care services.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Labor Code relating to the eligibility of certain physicians to provide and receive remuneration for workers' compensation health care services. Based on information provided by the Texas Department of Insurance, this analysis assumes that the duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
