**IN RE: HB3656** by Turner, Chris (relating to the classification of certain construction workers and the eligibility of those workers for unemployment benefits; providing penalties.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

It is assumed that the costs associated with the bill's provisions relating to the classification of certain construction workers and the eligibility of those workers for unemployment benefits could be absorbed using existing resources by the Texas Workforce Commission. According to the Comptroller of Public Accounts, the amounts and timing of any administrative penalty revenue are unknown and cannot be estimated at this time.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
