**IN RE: HB3722** by Zwiener (Relating to training materials for contact tracers and case investigators for public health disasters and other public health emergencies.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would require the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) to develop training materials related to contact tracing and case investigation during a public health disaster or other public health emergency and post the training materials on DSHS's website. DSHS indicated that the provisions of the bill could be implemented using existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
