**IN RE: HB3803** by Geren (Relating to the adoption of a certain plumbing code by the Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would require the State Board of Plumbing Examiners to adopt the 2015 edition of the International Plumbing Code. This analysis assumes there would be a minimal cost associated with implementing the provisions of the bill that could be absorbed within current resources.
