IN RE: HB3852 by Raney (Relating to requiring the disclosure of information by certain third-party sellers of consumer goods sold through an online marketplace.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Business & Commerce Code relating to requiring the disclosure of information by certain third-party sellers or consumer goods sold through an online marketplace.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed by the Office of the Attorney General using existing resources.

According to the Comptroller's Office, the fiscal impact from the bill cannot be estimated.
