IN RE: HB3899 by Sanford (relating to rating plan consequences for automobile insurance for traffic violation charges or convictions.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Insurance Code relating to rating plan consequences for automobile insurance for traffic violation charges or convictions. Based on information provided by the Texas Department of Insurance, this analysis assumes that the duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.
