**IN RE: HB3999** by Jetton (relating to the powers and duties of a presiding judge and alternate presiding judge in an election.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill's provisions relating to the powers and duties of a presiding judge and alternate presiding judge in an election could be absorbed using existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

According to the Fort Bend County Election Administrator, the bill's provisions would have no significant fiscal impact on Fort Bend County. According to the Williamson County Election Administrator, the bill's provisions would have a fiscal impact, requiring an additional expense of \$10,000 per election.
