**IN RE: HB4174** by Middleton (Relating to the disclosure under the public information law of certain evidence of a crime that resulted in the death of a person.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

It is assumed that the costs associated with the bill's provisions relating to the disclosure under the public information law of certain evidence of a crime that resulted in the death of a person could be absorbed using existing resources.

This analysis assumes the provisions of the bill would not result in a significant impact on state correctional populations or on the demand for state correctional resources.

The Texas Association of Counties does not anticipate a significant fiscal impact to counties.
