IN RE: HB4174 by Middleton (Relating to disclosure under the public information law of video evidence of a crime that resulted in the death of a person to the deceased person's next of kin.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that the costs associated with the bill's provisions relating to disclosure under the public information law of video evidence of a crime that resulted in the death of a person to the deceased person's next of kin could be absorbed using existing resources.

This analysis assumes the provisions of the bill would not result in a significant impact on state correctional populations or on the demand for state correctional resources.
